





Simple Present


The simple tense is used to express habitual or everyday activity.

- I get up at seven every morning.
- I always eat a salad for dinner.

It also used to express Some thing was true in the past, is true in the present and will be true in the future (Like general statement of facts and general truth)


The Simple Present Tense

This tense also expresses general truths or facts that are timeless.



Snow <u>falls</u> in the December in Minnesota. Water <u>boils</u> at 100 degrees Celsius.

Present Continuous Tense



The present progressive Tense express an activity that is in progress at the moment of speaking

It is a temporary activity that is begin in the past, is continuing at present and will end at some point in the future

Examples

- The students are sitting at their desk right now.
- I need an umbrella because it is raining
- I am taking five courses this semester.
